## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading List – 2018

For students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade

Dear Entering 6<sup>th</sup> Graders,

Summer is just around the corner and with its arrival comes the opportunity to plan for great vacation reading choices. Our summer reading goal is to invite students to read widely and to discover new areas of interest. Reading is a great way to keep your mind active and growing while you are away from school. The goal is for you to read at least 20 minutes per day. Studies show that good readers naturally spend more time in daily reading. Exposure to reading is important in developing vocabulary for fluency and comprehension. **Your goal this summer is to read 100 minutes per week.**

All students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade are expected to read a total of **three** books during the summer. The **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading List** serves as a guide to the wide selection of books that are available at your public library, bookstores, and book/magazine sections at Walmart.

### Entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading Requirements:

- All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students are **required** to read ***Freak the Mighty*** AR 5.5 by Rodman Philbrick.
- In addition, choose **two** additional books from the **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer Reading List** or select other titles that satisfy your reading interests based on your end of year STAR Reading ZPD.
- Once you have completely read the book, students should complete a summary for all **three** books. This should include the title, author, number of pages read, a complete summary of the book, and your personal thoughts toward the book. **The activity will be due to your teacher the second week of school (August 24<sup>th</sup>). This assignment will count as one reading test grade during the first nine weeks of school.**
- Each summary should be at least three to four paragraphs long. It should demonstrate a complete understanding and interpretation of the text, exhibit a level of comprehension that extends beyond the literal and into the personal thought. It should be written demonstrating command of the conventions of Standard English grammar usage.
