- 1. Mr. Grissom gave the Board an overview of the opening of school. The day the teachers returned, everyone was involved in some high energy team building activities. All four schools reported smooth openings. Several teachers have emailed or spoken to DO personnel about how upbeat this year has begun.
- 2. Mr. Grissom shared the following information concerning the 2014 ACT Scores. Barnwell School District 45 is happy to announce a 1.2 point gain in ACT scores last school year. Barnwell High School's mean composite score improved from 18.9 for 2013 to 20.1 in 2014. According to ACT officials, districts and schools that have a 0.3 point increase or greater show statistically significant improvement. Barnwell School District 45 and Barnwell High School are among 32 school districts and 94 schools in South Carolina that saw this type

of improvement. We are very proud of the achievement of our students and the hard work and dedication of our teachers and administrators.
