**DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:**

**On February 6, 2020 at approximately 7:52 AM a juvenile walking to the Nyack Middle School states that at the intersection of Depew Ave and Route 9W in the Village of Nyack, a male described as black, medium complexion with a beard, approximately 40 years of age, wearing a black hoodie, operating a vehicle described as an older model black Lincoln Town car with yellow New York registration plates, tinted windows, damage to drivers side of vehicle pulled up to him and requested that he get in the vehicle and he would drive him to school. The juvenile refused to get in the vehicle and kept walking towards the Nyack Middle School. The vehicle followed the juvenile for approximately 500 feet and the juvenile lost sight of the vehicle when he continued to the school. The juvenile reported the incident to school officials who contacted the police department.**
