How can I stay informed?



District Newsletters, District Calendar, and PRSD Code of Conduct

are mailed to all district residents. These documents inform the parents and community of important school policies, events, school budget information, and school report information.

K12 Alerts System

K12 Telephone Alerts- This system is used for emergencies and school closings. All district parents are automatically enrolled in our K12 telephone alert system.

K12 Email and Text Alerts- Most PRSD communications to parents, guardians, and residents are in the form of email. If you would like to receive information from the district office, your child(ren)'s school(s), and community notices, you need to sign up for K12 Email and Text Alerts.

Parents: You have the ability to enroll at the time of student registration. You may also call 620-3918 for your personal log-in to review your information and make any changes. Once you sign up for email and/or texting, you will receive district-wide news and school-specific notices from your child(ren)'s school(s).

Residents: Self-register using an email address for general district notices.

Parent Portal

The eSchoolData Parent Portal enables you to login to view your child(ren)'s school information, including attendance and report cards. In addition, at the middle and high school levels, you will be able to view your child(ren)'s schedule, interim progress reports, and individual assignment grades.

To login, go to your child(ren)'s school webpage from www.pearlriver.org and click "Parent Portal" under *Quick Links for Parents* at the bottom of the screen. If you need a parent user id and password, please contact 620-3913 to schedule an in-person pick-up or postal mailing. Note that due to the confidentiality of your student(s)'s data, we cannot provide the login information over the phone or via email.

As always, if you have any questions or concerns about your child(ren)'s grades, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher(s) directly.

BoardDocs

All board of education meeting agendas and minutes are posted on Board Docs. This system allows us to significantly reduce the amount of paper generated for each meeting and better manages the documentation and formatting of the agenda items.
