District Newsletters, District Calendar, & PRSD Code of Conduct

These documents inform the parents and community of important school policies, events, school budget information, and school report information. The district calendar is mailed to each Pearl River resident in late summer. District newsletters and the Code of Conduct are emailed to parents and guardians and are available on our website at www.pearlriver.org.

SchoolMessenger Notification System

In the event of a school closing, early dismissal due to inclement weather or an unforeseen emergency, the district will communicate with parents through our notification system, SchoolMessenger. The system utilizes phone calls, email, and text messages as a means of broadcasting important information. All parents are automatically registered to receive phone calls and email messages based on their contact information in their eSchoolData Parent Portal. The majority of our communications are through email. If you are not receiving emails from the district or your child(ren)'s school(s), your contact information is not current in your Parent Portal. Wireless carriers require verification that a mobile phone number has agreed to allow SchoolMessenger to send it text messages. Each mobile phone in the Parent Portal will receive a text message from SchoolMessenger short code '67587'. To opt-in to receive text messages, you will need to reply 'Y'. **If you do not reply to this message, you will not be enrolled to receive text messages from Pearl River School District.**

Please login to your Parent Portal account to ensure all contact information is accurate. If you require any changes, please contact your child(ren)'s school(s).

Parent Portal

The eSchoolData Parent Portal enables you to login to view your child(ren)'s school information, including attendance and report cards. In addition, at the middle and high school levels, you will be able to view your child(ren)'s schedule, interim progress reports, and individual assignment grades.

To login, go to your child(ren)'s school webpage from www.pearlriver.org and click *Parent Portal* under *Quick Links for Parents* at the bottom of the screen.

If you need a parent user id and password, please contact 620-3913 to schedule an in-person pick-up or postal mailing. Note that due to the confidentiality of your student(s)'s data, we cannot provide the login information over the phone or via email.

BoardDocs

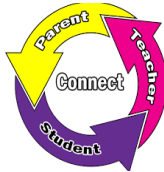
