Concert 2 – Wednesday, May 15th

7th Grade Band - High School Library
 7th & 8th Grade Chorus – High School Cafeteria
 8th Grade Band – High School Band Room

Students will leave their cases in these assigned rooms. Once they have completed their performance they will report back to their assigned rooms. Students cannot leave these rooms until an adult comes to pick them up.

Students who are in multiple groups are to check in with the room of their second performance and STAY in the room of their first performance.

The dress code for all students will be:

- Top: WHITE shirt/blouse covering shoulders (no t-shirts)
- Bottom: BLACK dress pants (no jeans) skirts knee-length or longer
- Shoes: Nice dress shoes (no sneakers or flip flops)
- Ties: Optional

Students are responsible for bringing their own instrument and music to the concert. It is important that students bring their instruments home the day of the concert because they will not be allowed back into the middle school that evening.

Concert attendance is **MANDATORY**. Any student with an unexcused absence will automatically be given a zero for that performance grade. Students who are sick the day of the concert are required to bring in a note the next school day or upon their return. If there are any conflicts, please speak to your music teacher as soon as possible.
