Children under age 18 must be accompanied by a Parent, Legal Guardian, Grandparent, Adult Aunt/Uncle, or Adult Brother/Sister. Please bring the child's immunization record to each clinic site.

Free vaccinations are available to persons 18 years of age and younger. Persons 19 years of age and older may attend the Adult Immunization and Screening clinic. Anyone needing vaccinations for travel, should contact 845-486-3504 for an appointment.
