

Update from CCPS – March 30, 2020

Good Morning CCPS Students, Families, Faculty, Staff and Community --

As we head into this coming week, a few reminders for everyone to get our week started:

1. Grab and Go Meals will continue starting today each weekday, Monday through Friday, between 11 AM and 1 PM at the back bus loop of Charles City High School by the Gymnasium. We want to give a big shout out to our Food Service Department for providing each of our families who have participated with healthy options for lunch and breakfast each day so far. Upwards of 100 meals each day have been served with a lot of care and love and we cannot thank you enough!

2. As a reminder, next week during Spring Break, meal service will not take place from April 6th through April 10th. We will resume with our Grab and Go Meal service on April 13th.

3. Our Tiger Packs and Community Den programs will continue to be open to our families every Friday from 11 AM to 1 PM at Charles City Elementary School. So far, Ms. Leek and our faculty and staff volunteers and community have donated and provided food, dry goods and supplies to upwards of 60 to 70 of our families each week. Thank you to our amazing community sponsors and supporters for helping to ensure that our shelves remain stocked for those in need.

4. We handed out around 65% of our student learning packets last week. Thank you to our families who came by to pick up student work and assignments. Any remaining learning packets were mailed to the student's home address of record in our student information system at 1 PM last Friday, so please be on the lookout for your student's learning packet in the mail if you could not make it to one of the pick up times last week.

We will be providing our students and families with updates and information on pick up for completed work, as well as how CCPS intends to move forward with our learning after April 13th for the remainder of the year. Our leadership and instructional team will be meeting this week to finalize our CCPS Plan for Learning from April through June and will be posting this information for our students and community, as well as sharing it through our alert system in the coming week. Thank you for everyone's partnership and support of student learning thus far and for making sure that student engagement and continuity of learning comes first.

6. Our school buildings will remain closed for the next two weeks to the public while we finish cleaning and sanitizing everything in them. We will be holding Special Education meetings and other required meetings on a limited basis through the next few weeks; however, our schools and offices will remain closed to do our part with helping to flatten the curve and keeping our social distance.
