**Math: Topic 1: Understanding Addition and Subtraction**

- 2.OA.1 - Use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve 2 one- and two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing, with unknowns in all positions, e.g., by using drawings and equations with a symbol for the unknown number to represent the problem.
- .NBT.5 - Fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.
