

# AFTER SCHOOL SNACK PROGRAM

## PURPOSE

- Enhance nutrition benefits
- Provide after school care
- Provide education and/or enrichment activities
- Reduce or prevent involvement in :
  - juvenile crime
  - high risk behavior

## ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS

- School participates in the NSLP
- Provide care in after school settings
  - regularly scheduled activities
  - structured and supervised
- Include educational or enrichment activities

## ELIGIBLE SITES

- Must be operated by the school
  - school enters into the agreement with the state agency
- Assumes responsibility for meeting program requirements
- May delegate day-to-day operations to another organization

## NOT ELIGIBLE

- Organized Athletic Programs in Interscholastic Sports
- Extracurricular Activities- Choir, Band, Debate, Drama, unless basic purpose is to provide after-school care
- Community Level Competitive Sports

## REIMBURSEMENT

- One snack, per child, per day
- Eligible through age 18
- Rates are determined annually by USDA
- Reduced-price may not exceed 15 cents
- Maintain free and reduced-price applications to document eligibility

### “Area Eligible”

- At least 50% of the children enrolled in school are certified free or reduced-price
- All snacks reimbursed at the free rate

### Not “Area Eligible”

- Less than 50% of the children enrolled in school are certified free or reduced-price
- Snack reimbursement at the free, reduced, or paid rate based on eligibility status

## ELIGIBILITY DATA

- Schedule A: Record enrollment and the number of free and reduced eligible as of the last day of operation for the most current October
