The **Annual Organizational Meeting** of the Board of Education of the City School District of New Rochelle will be held on **Tuesday, July 2, 2019, at 7:00 PM in the Board Room at Central Administration**, 515 North Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Fl., New Rochelle, New York.

At the Annual Organizational Meeting, the order of business differs from that of a Regular Meeting. Because the Board is without a President until after the nomination and election, the School District Clerk will serve as Chairperson Pro Tem.

After roll-call, the District Clerk will call for nominations for the office of President. Following the election, the new President will assume the Chair and call for nominations for the office of Vice President. The regular order of business will resume following the elections.

Two Board of Education members will participate via videoconferencing from 1) 770 W 47th St., Lobby, Kansas City, MO 64112; and 2) off the coast of Bermuda, latitude 32 degrees north 19.38, longitude 63 degrees west 41.34. The public has the right to attend the meeting at any of the locations.

An Installation Ceremony honoring newly elected Board of Education Members, William Iannuzzi and Valarie D. Williams, will be held immediately after the Organizational Meeting, followed by a reception with light refreshments in the area adjacent to the Board Room. All are welcome to attend.
