Please be FURTHER NOTIFIED and advised that certain provisions of Governor Cuomo's recent Executive Orders (202.1 et seq), which had suspended certain provisions of Article 7 of the Public Officer's Law relating to Open Meetings are scheduled to expire on July 6, 2020. In those expiring Executive Orders, the Governor had ordered the following as it relates to the Open Meetings Law:

Suspension of law allowing the attendance of meetings telephonically or other similar service:

Article 7 of the Public Officers Law, to the extent necessary to permit any public body to meet and take such actions authorized by the law without permitting in public in-person access to meetings and authorizing such meetings to be held remotely by conference call or similar service, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed.

If the Governor issues an Executive Order extending these provisions beyond the scheduled July 7, 2020 date of this Board of Education meeting, then the meeting will be conducted in compliance with those extended provisions, specifically, the meeting shall be conducted without permitting in-person access by the public. The meeting will be held via teleconference in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order.

If those prior Executive Order provisions modifying the Open Meetings Law are in fact extended, the public will be provided with the opportunity to listen to the meeting via teleconference at 7:00 PM by using the links which will be posted on our District website, www.nred.org on the morning of the meeting. The Board President will provide members of the public who are attending "virtually" with the opportunity to speak during the public comment portion of the meeting as set forth on the agenda.

In order to provide all of the public participants with the ability to listen to the meeting without interference, if you participate by teleconference we ask that you be reminded to keep device on mute to avoid having distortion, unless and until you are invited to speak. The meeting will also be recorded and later transcribed in accordance with the requirements of the Governor's Executive Order should those provisions be so extended.
