Dear Senior Counselor/Advisor:

It's time to begin prompting our students to reach for greatness, and apply for consideration in The Lower Great Lakes Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (*the Emmy® Awards people*) scholarship competition!

As we did last year, the Chapter will award two (2) \$2,000 scholarship to graduating high school seniors. Eligible are students who attend schools in the membership area of our organization. That includes the television markets of Cleveland, Akron, Canton, Youngstown, Bowling Green, Toledo, Lima, and Mansfield, Ohio; Erie, Pennsylvania; Indianapolis, Fort Wayne, Bloomington, Lafayette and Muncie, Indiana.

Eligible students are those seniors who plan to attend a four-year college or university, and intend to pursue a career in television or a television-related field. The application process is completely online through our website, www.nataslgl.org. On the site, hover over the "Students" tab at the top right of the page, and then select "Scholarships" from the drop-down menu. Students may then fill out the online application.

Online applications must be completed by midnight February 28, 2019.

All applications will be screened by our scholarship committee, and finalists will be notified in March. Each finalist will then be interviewed by members of the Lower Great Lakes Chapter scholarship selection committee.

The scholarship recipient, and their parents or guardians, will receive complimentary tickets to the 50th Annual NATAS Lower Great Lakes Chapter Regional Emmy® Awards ceremony where they will receive on-stage recognition. This year's gala is planned for Saturday, June 15, 2019 at the Renaissance Cleveland Hotel in downtown Cleveland, Ohio.

The Lower Great Lakes Chapter of NATAS is investing in the future of the television industry and promoting excellence in television, the mission of our organization. We hope you will encourage your students to apply for these scholarships, and we look forward to hearing from them.
