

How are WISE projects evaluated?

1. The mentor will provide frequent feedback to the student about his/her project. The WISE rubric will serve as guidance for both students and mentors.
2. The mentor will complete an interim report at the end of the third marking period. This report will be mailed home.
3. If the project includes an internship, the on-site mentor will also complete an evaluation report which will be included with the mentor's interim report.
4. Mentors will complete a final evaluation report. This will include a discussion of the project, commentary on the student's successes and areas in need of improvement, documentation of the evaluation committees commendations and recommendations, and observations from the on-site mentor (if applicable). This report will be sent to the student's parents/guardians and become part of the student's permanent transcript.
5. Mentors will give each student a final grade of pass with honors, pass or fail. This grade will become part of the student's final transcript.
