

What factors will the mentor consider in writing the final evaluation?

The final evaluation is a permanent record of the student's WISE project. Faculty members should jot down notes during the presentation and the evaluation teams' commentary. The written evaluation should reflect:

- the quality and scope of the student's experience
- the relevance and scope of the research/reading
- the quality and depth of the journal
- the preparation for and performance during the presentation
- the student's demonstration of initiative, responsibility and independence
- the skills developed, intellectual maturity and social or other growth evidenced
