POLICY ON FAN BEHAVIOR

Consistent with provisions of Board of Education Policy 5621 Public Conduct on School Property, The Port Chester Rye Union Free School District fully endorses the following Board Policy on Fan Behavior.

All Code of Conduct expectations apply to spectators, players, coaches, and to all others present for an athletic event. The enclosed Policy will be available for dissemination.

Officials will stop a competition when any spectator(s), player, or coach displaying inappropriate or disruptive behavior, interferes with other spectators or participants of the game. Game officials will identify violators to security personnel for the purpose of removing them. Once removed, play will resume. Lost time will not be replaced and violators may be subject to further disciplinary action by the Board of Education and/or Police Department. Such inappropriate behavior shall include:

- Using obscene, belligerent, or disruptive language and/or gestures in any manner to any one at any time.
- Taunting players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, jeering, threatening physical violence, or actual physical violence.
- Throwing any object in the spectators' viewing area, players' benches, game area, or public area.

Violators will be escorted from the facility and not allowed to return. Please enjoy the game and support all players, coaches, and officials.
