Information contained in this report was derived from data reported by teachers on their individual BEDS electronic Personnel Master File (ePMF) forms in the fall of 2017 in conjunction with data contained in the Department's Teacher Certification database. When final, data contained in this report will be used in the New York State Report Cards and for federal reporting purposes. SIRS Reports 301 and 302 populated with scores for ELA and Math 3-8.

Posted On: 08/27/2018 L2RPT Reports SIRS 301 and SIRS 302 have now been populated with scores and performance levels for ELA and Math grades 3-8. Level 1 Reports will include the scores and performance levels within the next few days.

Please be aware that this data is embargoed and must remain confidential until the public release of the data at the end of September. While this embargo is in effect, data cannot be shared at public venues, with parents or students, with 3rd party vendors, or be removed from the school setting. It should be used solely for student placement and curriculum planning by teachers, counselors, specialists and administrators.
