

**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**  
**Society of Women Engineers – Richmond Section**

ELIGIBILITY – Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- Identify as female and be entering the first year of college/university. Applicants must live or attend high school in one of the following municipalities:
  - Cities: Richmond, Colonial Heights, Hopewell and Petersburg
  - Counties: Charles City, Chesterfield, Dinwiddie, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, New Kent, Powhatan, and Prince George
- Attend an ABET-accredited school to receive a bachelor's degree.
- Major in engineering or computer science. Engineering technology programs are not eligible.
- Be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident.
- If selected as a scholarship recipient, be able to provide proof of enrollment.

DEADLINES

- All required materials must be submitted in pdf format and emailed on or before April 1, 2020.
- Interviews of candidates, if necessary, will be held in early-May.
- Scholarship recipient will be notified by May 21, 2020.

APPLICATION – To be considered for the scholarship, an applicant must submit the following:

1. Application Form
2. Applicant Letter – A statement or letter written by the applicant, addressed to the Scholarship Award Committee, not more than two typed pages in length and briefly describing:
  - Why the applicant would like to be an engineer
  - The applicant's definition of engineering
  - Why the applicant wants/needs this scholarship
  - Any special circumstances, or other information that the applicant would like the committee to consider
3. Reference Letter(s) – these may be emailed directly by the writer.
  - One letter of reference from a math or science teacher
  - If employed or volunteering in a technical position, one letter of reference from a supervisor
4. Copy of Acceptance Letter – A copy of an acceptance letter into an ABET-accredited school showing that the student will be pursuing a degree in engineering or computer science in the Fall of 2020.
5. Transcript – A copy of the most recent high school transcript; including the **unweighted** GPA (4.0 scale).
