## D. Paul Karnes Scholarship

### Guidelines

The D. Paul Karnes Scholarship, sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell, is available to senior students at Hopewell High School and Prince George High School who will attend a college or university with preference given to current members of the Hopewell High School and Prince George High School Kiwanis Key Clubs. The Scholarship award is \$1,000.00 per year for four (4) years and is paid directly to the school to which the recipient will attend.

#### BACKGROUND:

The D. Paul Karnes Scholarship was established in 2013 by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell to honor the memory of D. Paul Karnes. Mr. Karnes was a charter member of the newly chartered Kiwanis Club of Hopewell and a Past President of the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell. Mr. Karnes was a lifelong resident of Hopewell, a graduate of Hopewell High School and a former Mayor of the City of Hopewell. He was often known as "Mr. Hopewell" because of his service to the many organizations with whom he was affiliated.

#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Submit a completed application form.
2. Submit evidential documentation of acceptance to a college or university to which you will attend as a full-time student and for which the scholarship award will be used.
3. Submit the following materials/information for consideration by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell. Applicants receive points in each area as shown below for a maximum cumulative total of 30 points.
  - a. Describe your financial need. (See application). (5 points)
  - b. Academic: (5 points)
    - i. Submit a copy of all high school transcripts including Class Rank and Grade Point Average.
    - ii. (Optional) Submit a copy of your SAT/ACT Scores
4. Provide a list and description of extracurricular activities, community service activities and awards. (See application). (10 points)
5. Provide a brief essay regarding your personal goals, your planned career pursuits and where you see yourself in 20 years. (See application). (10 points)

#### Deadline:

Scholarship applications must be returned to the guidance office by April 2, 2020.
