

PRINCE GEORGE HIGH SCHOOL SOL Testing

Important Information:

- ☐ **ALL backpacks:** Once testing begins, students will not be allowed access their backpack for any personal items or electronic devices **FOR ANY REASON** until both testing sessions are completed.
- ☐ **Please do not bring a purse or other electronic devices to your testing site.** NO personal items, I-Pods, or CD players, etc. will be allowed at the testing table.
- ☐ **Cell phones must be turned off completely and placed at the front of the classroom.** Students may not have cell phones in their possession at the testing table. **IF A STUDENT HAS A CELL PHONE AT THEIR TESTING TABLE, THEIR EXAM WILL BECOME NULL AND VOID. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- ☐ Get a good night's sleep the night before each exam, and eat a good breakfast each morning.
- ☐ Dress in layers as the temperature in your testing site may vary.
- ☐ PGHS recommends you report to your testing site **10 minutes** prior to the beginning of the school day.
- ☐ Typically, most students complete the exam by lunch. However, because this is an un-timed exam, some students may not finish until after the regularly scheduled lunch period. If you think you might take additional time, we recommend that you bring a sack lunch to eat after you have completed the exam.
- ☐ No food or drink will be allowed on any testing table.
- ☐ **SNACKS:** You may bring a snack to eat during a short break scheduled between the two sections on each day. All students must remain inside their testing site during the Break. Snacks brought to the testing table must be kept on the floor until the designated break. If you wish to bring your snack in a bag, **it must be a clear plastic bag not a paper sack, plastic grocery bag, or lunch box.**
- ☐ After you have completed the exam each day, you must sit quietly until you are dismissed from the testing site. State testing policy does not allow students to have homework, books, magazines, etc. at the testing table.
