Spring Fling Arts Scholarship Application

The Fine Arts Educators in Prince George County are pleased to provide a scholarship to a graduating Prince George Country Public Schools student who has been actively involved in their fine arts discipline while in school and intends to pursue this discipline in college study.

Criteria:

- This scholarship will be given to a student who has studied: Theatre, Vocal Music, Instrumental Music or Visual Art for at least three of the past five years and maintained a B-average or better in those courses.
- A scholarship candidate must also show proof of acceptance into an approved college program in the area in which he/she prepared while attending the Prince George County Schools.
- Include two letters of recommendation: 1) from a Fine Arts teacher and 2) from one other adult source outside of school and family (i.e. job, church, community member)
- Attach a persuasive essay explaining why you would be a good candidate for this scholarship. Include information about your experience in Prince George and plans for your future in the arts. Convince us you have earned this award and will make us proud! Essay should not exceed one page double spaced.
- Include any additional information/attachments you feel may assist the scholarship committee in making their decision.
- Completed application must be submitted by April 24, 2020 to Ms. Cindy Bell or Ms Angie Corrigan at PGHS.

\*Currently enrolled Prince George Students who attend Prince George High School will take priority during the consideration process.
