Scholarship Guidelines

The Homer C. Eliades Scholarship, sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell, is available to seniors at Hopewell High School and Prince George High School who will attend a college or university. The Scholarship is a one time award of \$1,500 and is paid directly to the school the recipient will attend.

BACKGROUND:

The Homer C. Eliades Scholarship was established in 2017 by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell to honor the memory of Homer C. Eliades. Mr. Eliades started his relationship with the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell in 1956 and was a Past President of the club. Mr. Eliades was a lifelong resident of Hopewell and worked as an attorney in the area until his death in 2016. He was very active in our community in various organizations and was noted for his passionate involvement with the John Tyler Community College system where he was a founding member of their Board and Foundation.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Submit a completed application form.
2. Submit evidential documentation of acceptance to a college or university to which you will attend as a full time student and for which the scholarship will be used.
3. Submit the following materials/information for consideration by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell. Applicants receive points in each area as shown below for a maximum cumulative total of 30 points.
 - a. Describe your financial need. (See application). (5 points)
 - b. Academic: (5 points)
 - i. Submit a copy of all high school transcripts including Class Rank and Grade Point Average.
 - ii. (Optional) Submit a copy of your SAT/ACT scores.
4. Provide a list and description of extracurricular activities, community service activities and awards. (See application). (10 points)
5. Provide a brief essay regarding your personal goals, your planned career pursuits and where you see yourself in 20 years. (See application). (10 points)

Scholarship applications must be returned to the guidance office by April 2, 2020.
