Dr. Trent Wilson Scholarship

Guidelines

The Dr. Trent Wilson Scholarship, sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell, is available to seniors at Hopewell High School and Prince George High School who will attend a college or university. The Scholarship is a one time award of \$1,500 and is paid directly to the school to which the recipient will attend.

BACKGROUND:

The Dr. Trent Wilson Scholarship was established by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell to honor the memory of Dr. Trent Wilson. Dr. Wilson attained career perfect attendance as a faithful member of the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell. Dr. Wilson was a resident of Hopewell and local dentist for many years.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Submit a completed application form.
2. Submit evidential documentation of acceptance to a college or university to which you will attend as a full time student and for which the scholarship will be used.
3. Submit the following materials/information for consideration by the Kiwanis Club of Hopewell. Applicants receive points in each area as shown below for a maximum cumulative total of 30 points.
 - a. Describe your financial need. (See application). (5 points)
 - b. Academic: (5 points)
 - i. Submit a copy of all high school transcripts including Class Rank and Grade Point Average.
 - ii. (Optional) Submit a copy of your SAT/ACT Scores.
4. Provide a list and description of extracurricular activities, community service activities and awards. (See application). (10 points)
5. Provide a brief essay regarding your personal goals, your planned career pursuits and where you see yourself in 20 years. (See application). (10 points)
