The rules governing play, eligibility and participation shall be those outlined by the Handbook of the New York State Public High School Athletic Association. Specific modified rules shall be governed by the General Eligibility Rules for the Modified Program which are listed in the modified section of the New York State Public High School Athletic Association Handbook.

- The standard starting time for games is 4:15pm. Games are not scheduled on weekends. Girls' soccer games are usually scheduled at Meadow Pond Elementary School.
- A student may participate in only one school-sponsored sport during a season.
- The team and individual maximum number of contests is 12 and athletes must have 10 practices to be eligible to compete in the first contest.
- Practices run from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm, Monday – Friday. Practices end in time for student athletes to take home the 5:30 activity bus. Teams generally practice 5 days a week.
- Sneakers or shoes with molded soles and molded cleats are permitted. Shoes with metal posts or spikes are not permitted. All players, including the goalie, must wear shin guards.
- The game is played with four 15-minute quarters.
- Students must be in school a minimum of five (5) periods to participate in practices/games.
