

Spring Sports Registration through Family ID

Online registration for spring sports opens February 20th is through FamilyID (www.familyid.com). FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to register for sports. Please go to the athletic web-page for more information on registering your child.

Registration on Family ID: February 20th – March 20th

You must register your child EACH SEASON they wish to participate on a team

Athletic Placement Process:

Information for 8th grade students interested in the APP process to try out for HS sports has been sent to all 8th grade households. For more information on the AP process, please refer to the athletic web page.

Modified (middle school) practices typically are 2:20 pm - 4:10 pm. A 4:15 activity bus is provided Monday thru Friday. There is a 5:30 activity bus Monday thru Thursday for practices that may run later.

Application Guidelines

- Students must have a current physical on file. Students who carry inhalers, epipens or have any other special concerns must have updated medication forms completed by their physician on file in the health office. Forms available in the nurse's office or on-line on the athletic web page.
- Registration opens for modified (middle school) sports February 20th. . *You will not be able to register for modified sports prior to the 20th.* Failing to register your child or submit the required documents by the deadline may delay student's eligibility to participate.
- **Once your child has been successfully registered, you will receive a confirmation e-mail from FamilyID. Once your child has been approved from the nurses' office, or if additional information is needed, an e-mail will be generated from FamilyID.**
- Students must be transported to and from all athletic contests by school authorized vehicles. Parents may transport their child home from away games.
