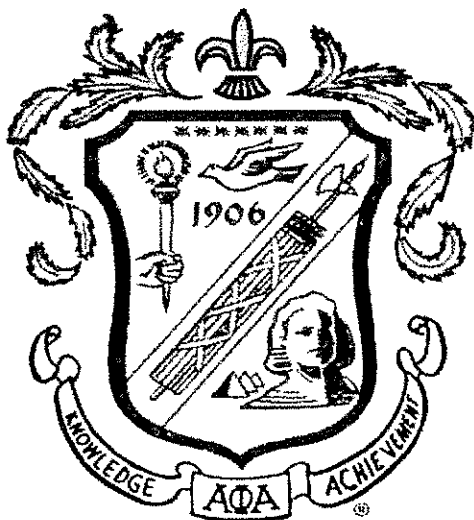

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated is among the oldest and most loyal investors in higher education in the United States. The fraternity began as a study group of Black men who defied racial segregation at Cornell University in 1906. Its concepts for community advancement and inclusion in higher education have created 692 chapters throughout the U.S., Africa, West Indies, Europe, Asia and the Virgin Islands. The Fraternity has been interracial since 1945, and over 175,000 Brothers have bonded to advance its ideals and precepts. In alignment with the fraternity's aim of "*manly deeds, scholarship and love for all mankind*", the Alpha Theta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha is proud to announce its 2018 Scholarship Program. Geared toward African American men, the Alpha Theta Lambda Chapter Scholarship Program seeks young men from the greater Southern New Jersey Region who will be matriculating at an institution of higher education in the **Fall 2018 term** and whose aspirations align with the fraternity's aims.

Eligibility

All applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.00 grading scale. **If GPA is reported on a different scale other than a 4.00 scale, you are required to have the GPA converted by a school official.** Official documentation must be provided. Selected high school applicants are eligible to receive a scholarship up to \$500.00.

Requirements to Apply

Recommendation

- One recommendation from an adult non-relative
For example, a high school teacher, counselor, social worker, religious official or school principal.

Personal Statement

- Applicants must submit a 1-2 page typed, double-spaced essay. The personal statement should be thoughtfully and clearly written, but succinct. The statement should address the following criteria:
 - A brief biography about yourself
 - A description of your scholastic and career ambitions
 - A description of your involvement in current extra-curricular and community service activities
 - A statement of why you deserve the scholarship

Supporting Documents

- Copy of current school identification card
- A current sealed and certified academic transcript. **If GPA is reported on a different scale other than a 4.00 scale, you are required to have the GPA converted by a school official.**
- An official letter of acceptance from the college or university for which you will be attending in the Fall 2016 term (if available).

Submission of Application Materials (*Deadline to Apply: Tuesday, May 15, 2018*)

- Recommendation, personal statement, supporting documents and the completed application form must be submitted by the application deadline.
- **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
