Essay question guidelines: you will have 650 words to respond to one of the following Essay Questions listed below. Essays should be typed, 12 Inch Times New Roman Font, and double spaced with one inch margins.

1. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience? How have you recovered from a mistake, challenge or disappointment?

2. Discuss a historical figure or a role model that inspires you.

OR

3. Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
