The Pocantico Hills Day Camp has a full schedule of activities and events lined up for this summer, including day trips to exciting destinations, playing games in our new Gaga Ball Pit, swim lessons and free swim, cooking, camping out, and taking wilderness walks on the beautiful Rockefeller trails that surround our campus.

We welcome students who are entering pre-kindergarten (must have turned 4 by July 1st) through rising ninth-graders. Rising 10th-graders can work as counselors-in-training and have the camp fee waived as compensation.

Campers are placed in one of three divisions: primary (pre-kindergarten through grade 2); intermediate (grades 3-6); and middle school (grade 7 and teens).

Our specialists enrich our camp offerings in the following areas: arts and crafts; primary athletics; secondary athletics; studio; culinary; and wilderness.

Please note:

- The camp provides transportation for in-district children for the regular camp day. Transportation is not provided for the pre-camp and post-camp programs.
- Children must bring their lunch. Lunch will be refrigerated. There is no food service on campus during the summer.
- The camp will be closed on July 4.
- Additional fees will apply for selected teen trips.
