



“Camp Poco To Go!” FAQs

Q: What will the “Camp Poco TO Go” virtual program look like?

A: “Camp Poco TO Go” is a 4-week online day camp program. Each week will be centered around a specific theme. Campers can log on to Microsoft Teams to access both recorded and Live sessions with our Camp Poco Specialists.

Q: Who can attend the “Camp Poco TO Go” Program?

A: “Camp Poco TO Go” is open to both Pocantico residents and Non-residents. Campers ranging in ages from Rising Pre-K to Rising 9th grade are invited to register.

Q: How do I register for the “Camp Poco TO Go” virtual program?

A: The 4-week online day camp program registration is open on the Pocantico Hills district website under the Community/Day Camp tab. Please log on to the [Campsite Parent Portal](#) to register your camper(s) for the Virtual Program. Each camper participating in the program must be registered. If you had previously completed the registration process for PHDC, you still need to enroll in the virtual program.

Q: When does the “Camp Poco TO Go” Program take place?

A: “Camp Poco TO Go” runs for four consecutive weeks beginning on Monday, July 6th and ending on Friday July 31st.

“Stars and Stripes!” Week 1: July 6th-July 10th

“Poco Camp Out!” Week 2: July 13th-July 17th

“Superheroes!” Week 3: July 20th-July 24th

“Color War!” Week 4: July 27th-July 31st

Q: When will the Live and Recorded content be available?

A: "Camp Poco TO Go" recorded sessions and other online content will be available beginning the Sunday night before the Themed week begins. This content will be available for unlimited access until "Camp Poco To Go" ends on July 31st. Live sessions will be scheduled each week. They will occur between 9am and 3pm each camp day. A sign up for the Live sessions will be emailed to parents before the Themed week begins. Live sessions will run with a minimum of 5 campers and will be closed at 50 campers.

Q: What is the cost of the "Camp Poco TO Go" Program?

A: "Camp Poco TO Go" is available for \$100 per family for all 4 weeks. While each camper must be registered, each family will only be charged one family access fee.

Q: What materials do campers need to participate in the "Camp Poco TO Go" Program?

A: Campers can access Microsoft Teams from any device with the Teams app (laptop, iPad, smart phone.) Live and recorded content will incorporate the materials in the supplemental supply kits. While not mandatory, campers will be able to make the most of the virtual experience using the supply materials and craft items.

Q: Why "Camp Poco TO Go" this summer?

A: "Camp Poco TO Go" facilitators will be working to make this season special despite the challenges that Summer 2020 presents. In addition to transforming our Camp Poco activities and traditions to a virtual format, staff will be focused on building camper engagement both on and off the screens. Providing opportunities for campers to socialize and stay connected with friends is a priority!
