



Bus Rules for Students



- Always stay out of the school bus danger zones; stand back at least 15 feet. Do not play near the bus, especially near the tires.
- Use the fifteen foot rule if you have to cross the street getting on or off the bus. Always cross in front so you can see the driver's face. Do not cross until the driver signals it is safe.
- Always stay in your seat on the bus, unless the bus is fully stopped and you are getting off.
- Know how to evacuate the bus in an emergency.
- Observe the same conduct as in the classroom.
- Be courteous; use no inappropriate language; respect the driver and other students at all times.
- Do not eat, drink or chew gum on the bus.
- Keep the bus clean.
- Do not be destructive.
- Keep heads, hands and feet inside the bus and to yourself.
- Bus driver is authorized to assign seats.
- Do not run or chase the bus after it has left the bus stop or school grounds. This is extremely unsafe.
- Drivers will only pick up and drop off students at their authorized stops.
- No animals, reptiles or large items allowed on bus.
- Written permission must be submitted to the school office before riding a different bus or getting off at a different stop.
