Sophomores

The PSAT 10 will be offered to interested sophomores at Westbrook High School on Wednesday, **March 29 at 7:45 a.m.** The cost for taking the test is \$15.00. Counselors will visit 10th grade Social Studies classes after February vacation to distribute registration forms.

Juniors

Guidance will be presenting their Junior planning classroom presentations during the week of **February 6-9**. The same presentations will be offered to parents of Juniors on Thursday, **February 9th from 6:30-8:00 p.m.** in the high school library.

If your child has taken the PSAT's, you will receive a copy of your child's scores and information to link to Khan academy.

The Junior class will be taking the school based SAT at Westbrook High School on Wednesday, **April 5 at 7:45 a.m.**

Seniors

Students need to be updating their college admissions decisions and they should be checking Naviance accounts regularly for scholarship information as it is updated weekly

Guidance will be visiting Senior classes in early February to find out which Seniors need to have their first semester grades sent to colleges. Counselors will send this information to colleges when first semester grades have been finalized.

The Westbrook Local Scholarship and the Westbrook Foundation Scholarships will be introduced to the Senior class in early March. The Guidance Department will provide classroom presentations walking seniors through the application process.
