1) Visit A Campus- Campus tours will help you narrow down prospective colleges by showing you what you like and dislike.

- 2) Apply Early- Do NOT leave your college applications until the last minute. The earlier the application, the better your chances of getting in.
- 3) Proofread EVERYTHING- Make sure you check for spelling and grammar mistakes. Have multiple people proofread your college essay too!
   4) SAT/ACT Retakes- Taking the SAT/ACT more than once may improve your test score because you would be familiar with the test format.
- 5) Choose Recommendations Wisely- Pick teachers, counselors and others who know you well that will be considerate in writing their
