Nancy Evans read the treasurer's report . Motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Christine Anderson and Linda Benedict .Motion was carried.

Mr. Ihne spoke about the following :

- Construction - The schoolyard is open. Scaffolding will be put on the flag wall. The fence near the benches will be removed to extend the school yard . The project is extended an additional 8 months. A detailed letter will be sent home.

Kathy Stefanski spoke about the following :

- Kindergarten registration is now closed. Pre-K/3K February registration . 3K sites unavailable at this time . Pre-K is lottery 18 seats available .
- Puberty workshop for 5th girls will be held May 4th.
- Pre-K/ Kindergarten walk thru has been scheduled . Information will follow closer to the date.
- This Thursday is the self esteem workshop 12:30-2:30. March workshop topic is Testing.
- Shape Up with the NYC Parks Dept. for adults only information located on website.
- FDNY Smokehouse for grades 3-5 to come 5/17.
- Respect for All in February all grades participate . No child eats alone.
- School Survey to go home soon . Participation is extremely important .
- Movie Night -school needs a license in order to play movies for a movie night. A grant was written Nicotra fund. Admission will be \$5 to cover the cost of the movie and donate the rest. They will cover the license from January to June . Asking the PTA to cover the cost of next years license . Approximately \$600.
- Book Talk for grades 3- 4. Supplies limited. 32 kids are chosen . Books will be purchased by the PTA at the book fair.

Lori Nappi spoke about the following :

- Clothing Drive raised 422.20.
- Federation Scholarship collecting donations . A \$2000.00 scholarship is awarded to a student each year.
- Boosterthon 85% toward our goal. Kids are taught a new lesson each day by the Boosterthon team. Top 2 earners from each grade get to slime the principal.
