

# Honors Procedures For Students

If you wish to take an honors class next year, you must follow the procedures set by each department, as described below:

**English Honors:** All students **must complete an application** and provide **2 graded assignments**. The application and work samples **must be returned by February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. You will also be required to **sit for a placement exam**, which is tentatively scheduled for the **second week in March**. Once the date is confirmed, the time and place will be announced in classes. *Applications are available on-line on the English Department webpage.*

**Math Honors:** **All students** (regardless of current placement) **must complete an on-line application** for any Honors, AP, or summer accelerated math course. The application is due by **March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. *Applications are on-line on the Math Department webpage.*

**Science:** Any student who wishes to take an Advanced or AP level course next year **must complete an application** and hand it into the science department by **March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. *Applications are available on-line on the Science Department webpage.*

**Advanced Earth Science:** Have a **final average of at least 85%** in Living Environment and Algebra.

**Advanced Chemistry:** **Final average of at least 90%** in Living environment, Advanced Earth Science, Algebra and Geometry **AND BE** concurrently enrolled in Algebra 2 or higher.

**AP Physics 1:** **85% average or above** in ALL PREVIOUS math and science courses. (**Strong math skills**)

**World History AP:** Students must have an **88% average or higher**, as measured by their **MP1 & MP2 Global 1 grades**). Students must **email their teacher by February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020** to ask that the *Teacher Evaluation Form* for AP World History be completed. They must also complete an **on-line assignment on Google Classroom (u2p2kol)** and **submit a folder to Room 360A with all required documents before March 15<sup>th</sup>**.

**Foreign Language:** Students must have a **minimum average of 90%** for the first two marking periods, **be recommended by their teacher, and sit for a qualifying exam in March**. The time and place will be announced in classes.

- Qualifying test for 3 Honors – **Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>**, Whitney Young Auditorium, Periods 7 & 8
- Qualifying test for Pre-AP and AP – **Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>** – Whitney Young Auditorium, Periods 7 & 8
- **Make-up Day** – April 1<sup>st</sup> – Location TBD
