UNEMPLOYMENT

You can file your unemployment claim by phone: at **1-888-209-8124**

Extended Telephone Filing Hours are:
Mondays through Thursdays 8am – 7:30pm
Fridays 8am – 6pm
Saturdays 7:30am – 8pm

For people diagnosed, symptomatic, or quarantined for COVID-19, people caring for people with COVID-19, or people caring for children whose schools have closed because of COVID-19.
Employees are entitled to **80 hours of paid sick leave with full pay**, with a maximum of **\$5,110 total**.
If they work for employers of 499 employees or less, with limited exceptions, under federal law.

YOU CAN FILE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT IF YOU HAVE WORK AUTHORIZATION REGARDLESS OF STATUS
