Dear Parent/Guardian:

In order to comply with New York State Educational Medication Regulations, the School Physician will not be ordering OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS for our students. This includes medications such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol), Ibuprofen (Motrin/Advil), Benadryl, even cough drops and sunscreen.

In order to prepare for next year, I would like to know if your child will be receiving **ANY** medications at school. If this is the case, please complete the enclosed **Parent and Prescriber's Authorization form** which allows me to dispense the medication (provided by you) to your child in school. New York State law requires a new form completed each school year.

Part "A" is to be completed by you, the parent/guardian. Part "B" must be completed by the physician prescribing the medication for your child. Your doctor may fax the form to your School Nurse.

It is important that this form is completed so your child may be able to have his/her medication on the first day of school. If you have any question either about the form or the medication your child needs to receive in school please contact your School Nurse.
