Option #1 - APEX Learning

Credit Advancement

These classes are for highly motivated students who are able to self-pace during the summer. All semester exams must be taken with a parent or other adult home.. Students may enroll in only one online course during the summer session. Students should plan to devote at least 4 hours per day to working on an online class. A reliable internet connection with the capability to stream video is mandatory. ***Students and parents must attend orientation and sign an online agreement.***

Differences between APEX Learning & Virtual Virginia Credit Advancement Opportunities

PHS Online Economics & Personal Finance

In this course required for graduation, students will learn how to make informed decisions related to career exploration, budgeting, banking, credit, insurance, taxes, saving & spending, investing, managing debt, retirement, inheritance, and living independently.

Student and parent orientation will be posted in Schoology once a student registers.

Course Session: June 8 - July 24

Cost: \$300.00. **No Refunds**

Economics and Personal Finance culminates with a financial literacy test (W!SE Test) that serves as a CTE certification toward graduation. This test must be taken at PHS. The test is an integral part of the class. During each testing window, the test may be taken up to three times in order to pass.

W!SE Test dates: July 24, 29 & 30

Online Health/PE for Grade 9 and 10

Students are required to successfully complete the course content and plan/implement a personal wellness/activity plan. Seventy hours of physical activity plus the equivalent of 70 hours of online health instruction are necessary. The final grade will be based on written assessments and the quantity/quality of physical activity. With the exception of fitness testing and health assessments, all activities will be completed off campus. The course must be started no later than June 14 to ensure that students have enough time to complete the course requirements by July 31. The midterm will be open at 6:00 on July 7 and closed at 8:00 that day. The final will be opened at 6:00 on July 31, and closed at 8:00 that day. Students and their parents will be required to attend an orientation and sign a usage agreement.

Mandatory Orientation Date: June 8, 6:00 p.m. via zoom.

A second meeting on June 10 at 6:00 via zoom will be offered for technical connectivity for those who need extra assistance.

Registration: May 26 through June 12 via PHS online registration form

Course Session: June 14 - July 31

Cost: \$200 plus the cost of a fitness band. Students are required to have bands that are enabled for heart-monitoring and the band prices begin at approximately \$100. Fitness bands for this course may either be a **Polar band or a Garmin band**. Any Polar model with a heart rate sensor will work or the Garmin Vivo line with a heart rate sensor. Please assess your choice of activity and purchase a band that works for your activities and price point.

Driver Education Classroom

This will be a combination of online and face to face zoom time. Students will need to have access to reliable internet and a computer. Students will need to log the time they work on their own as well as the zoom meetings. This time must be a minimum of 36 hours.

Registration: May 26-June 19 via PHS Online Registration Form

Course Session: June 29-July 31. The course will begin June 29 at 8:00 a.m. with a zoom meeting and finish on July 31.

Cost: Cost of this course is \$150. This does not include behind the wheel.
