2017-2018 Guidelines for Community Service:

Here at Nyack Middle School we encourage the building of character through volunteering in the community. Students can work at non-profit organizations, schools, libraries, houses of worship, community out-reach programs, etc. We recognize students who complete 15 hours or more of community service in the following two ways:

Ambassador's Award: This award is given to students with Community Service hours who have **not** been on the Honor Roll or High Honor Roll for the first three quarters of the school year.

Principal's Award: This award is given to students with Community Service hours who have achieved Honor Roll or High Honor Roll for all of the first three quarters of the school year.

Hours can be gathered from a combination of places. When completed, the students request a letter on the organization's letter head, which should state: the students name, date of service, number of hours worked, type of work performed and signed by the coordinator.

When **all 15 hours have been completed**, they should be handed in to the Middle School Guidance Office. The deadline for handing in the completed hours is ***Friday, April 20, 2018***. Your child will then be recognized at our Awards' Ceremony which will be held ***Wednesday, May 16, 2018***.
