

POLICIES/REGULATIONS

- A. Students must leave the building after their last summer school course. Loitering on school grounds will NOT be permitted.
- B. Personal audio devices, skateboards, etc. are not permitted on school grounds. Cell phones and cameras will be confiscated.
- C. Rockland BOCES is not responsible for loss of personal items.
- D. Smoking, including vapor cigarettes, is not allowed on school grounds as defined by Federal and State laws.
- E. Food and drink are permitted in designated areas only.
- F. Parking is permitted in designated areas only.

PARTICIPATION POLICY

The following policy applies to all summer school students and is strictly enforced. All parents and students must read and understand the policy.

- 1. Students are expected to be in class when the period begins.
- 2. Any absence will cause a loss of 2 participation points.
- 3. Any tardiness or missed class time in excess of 15 minutes will cause a student to lose 2 participation points.
- 4. Any tardiness less than 15 minutes will cause a student to lose ½ participation point.
- 5. Any student with a loss of greater than 6 participation points will not earn a course grade.
- 6. Summer school staff will make every effort to notify parents or guardians when participation points are lost due to attendance.
- 7. A student's home school will be notified of dismissals and withdrawals.

PARKING

Students will be assigned parking by the security staff.

IMMUNIZATION

Students lacking the proper immunizations will not be permitted to attend summer school.

REGISTRATION

- A. **Summer School Courses** -DEADLINE: 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 6.
Registrations will not be accepted without approval from the home district. Students should inquire with individual guidance departments as to when registration will take place. North Rockland students MUST register at North Rockland High School during times indicated by NRHS.
 - 1. Registrations MUST be received in the summer school office no later than 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 6.
 - 2. Students may not enroll in more than TWO courses without the permission of the home school principal.
 - 3. Students may NOT select period(s).
 - 4. If registering at the Summer School office, students MUST **bring photo ID, copy of report card, copy of IEP/504 (if applicable), and bank check/money order (if applicable) in order to register.**

- B. **Regents/RCT Exams ONLY-DEADLINE: 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 20.**
Students NOT enrolling in summer school but who desire to take Regents or RCT Exams for a course they have completed at their home school must register either at their home school OR at the summer school office.
- C. **Regents Review Courses** -DEADLINE: 11:30 am on Friday, July 20.
Walk-In students who need preparation for the August Regents Exams must register in the Summer School office by 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 20.
- D. **Out of District Registration**
Students not attending a participating school district but whose parents reside in a participating school district MUST:
 - 1. Obtain a letter on school letterhead signed by their home school principal stating the necessary courses and include the student's NYS Student ID number.
 - 2. Register (and make payment, if applicable) in the high school or middle school guidance office in your participating district. Students can also register at the summer school office beginning Monday, July 2. Deadline for course registration is 11:30 a.m. on Friday, July 6. (Summer School office will be closed on July 4th.)
 - 3. Students MUST **bring photo ID, copy of report card, copy of IEP/504 (if applicable), and bank check/money order (if applicable) in order to register.**

REGISTRATION FEES

Registration fees for students in those districts not paying for Rockland BOCES Regional Summer School are as follows:

- \$499 per course (includes state exam if applicable)
- \$155 per exam (if not taking course at summer school)
- \$305 Earth Science Lab and Regents Exam
- \$200 per Regents Review Course

- A. Fees MUST be paid by money order or certified bank check payable to: **Haverstraw-Stony Point Central School District.**
- B. Please make a note of the **student's name and school district** on the money order or check.
- C. Payments must be made in FULL at registration.
- D. There will be no refunds for any individual once monies have been deposited.

REPORT CARDS/EXAMINATIONS

- A. Mid-Summer report cards will be mailed home by Tuesday, July 31.
- B. The last day of instruction and local exams will be Wednesday, August 15. Regents exams will be August 16th and 17th.
- C. A final exam will be given at the end of every course.
- D. Final summer school grades will be sent to districts and mailed home on Thursday, August 23.
