To get you started on your summer reading, we would like you to pick up a copy of ***The Misfits*** by **James Howe**. ***The Misfits*** is a great novel about a group of four friends that happen to attend middle school, just like you.

One theme or big idea that we will be focusing on throughout the year is resilience – having the ability to overcome a difficult time in your life or survive a painful experience.

As you read ***The Misfits***, we would like you to keep the theme of resilience in mind. After you finish the novel, write a one page response to the novel.

- a. Select one character from the novel that you think demonstrates resilience.
- b. Discuss the theme of resilience in ***The Misfits***
- c. Discuss the problem or issue the character faces and must overcome.
- d. Discuss how the character demonstrates resilience.
- e. Provide details and examples from the novel to support your ideas.

Your response should be:

- Typed
- 12 point font
- Times New Roman
- Double spaced

If you like *The Misfits*, there are three other books in the series for you to check out: *Addie on the Inside*, *Totally Joe*, and *Otherwise Known as Elvis*.
