



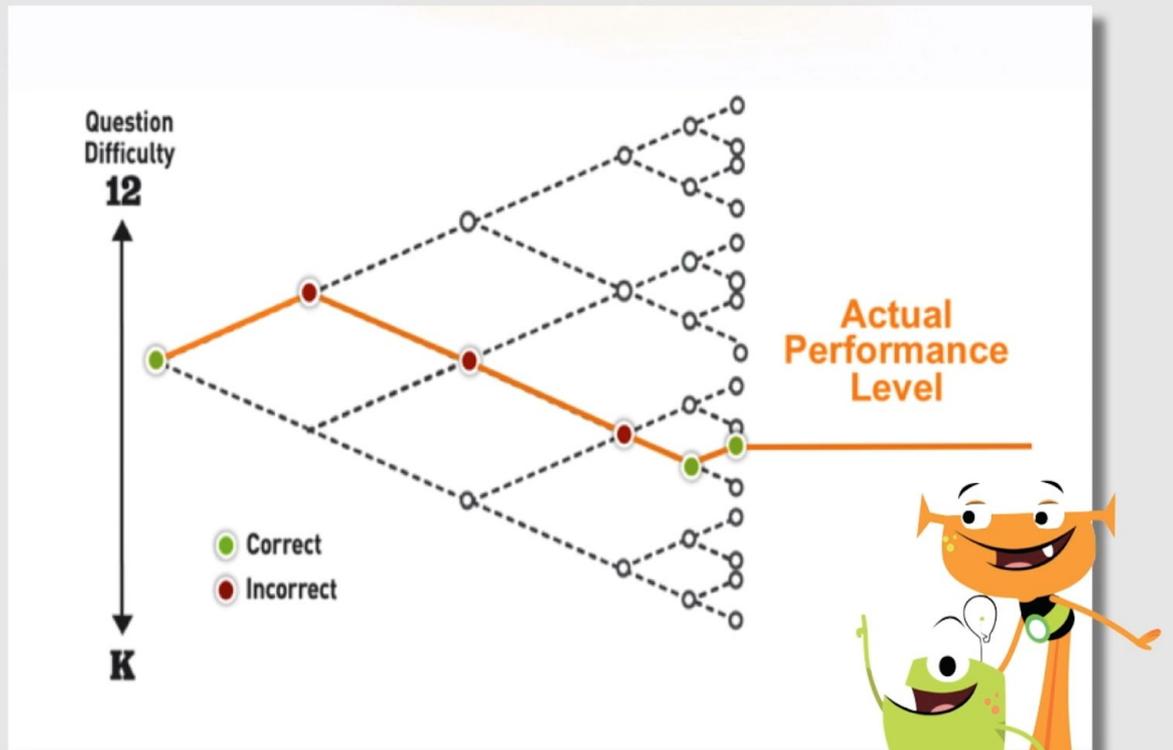
## WHAT IS I-READY?

i-Ready is an online program that will help us determine your child's strengths and areas for growth, personalize their learning, and monitor their progress throughout the school year. i-Ready allows us to meet your child where they are and provides us with data to inform instruction.

The i-Ready Diagnostic is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. Each item a student receives is based on their answer to the previous question. For example, a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions, while a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier ones. The purpose of this is not to give your child a score or grade, rather to help their teacher's determine how to best support their learning.

i-Ready Instruction provides students with lessons based on their individual strengths and areas for growth. These lessons are interactive and provide strategic supports to keep your child engaged as they learn.

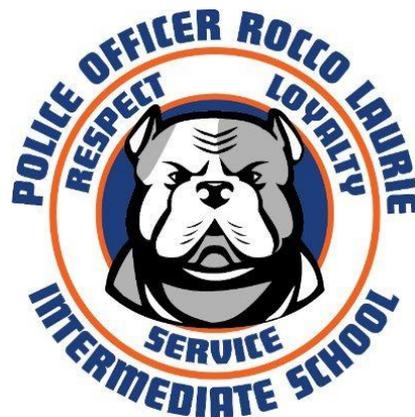
# Adaptive Diagnostic

## HOW TO LOG IN TO I-READY

1. Go to <https://login.i-ready.com>.
2. Username:
  - First letter of student's first name
  - First letter of the student's last name
  - Last six numbers of the student's OSIS number.
    - a. For example: Sean Benitez 225573403
      - i. My login would be SB573403
3. Password
  - Full birthday of the student (MM/DD/YEAR)
    - a. For example: July 20, 1983
      - i. My password would be 07201983

## WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP

To help prepare your child for the i-Ready Diagnostic, encourage them to:

- Get a good night's sleep and eat a full breakfast the day of the assessment.
- Find a quiet space for your child to take the assessment
- Try their best on each question and try not to rush.
- Try not to worry about questions they do not know—remind them that it is expected they will get only about half of the questions correct.
- Be respectful of other students who take longer to finish.
- Use paper and pencil to show work for math questions.

## FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF

- ❑ Watch this [video](#) to familiarize yourself with the Diagnostic and how to best support your child

## MOTIVATE YOUR CHILD

- ❑ Explain to your child (you can use [these phrases](#) to help you):
  - Why they are taking this Diagnostic, and motivate them to do their best
  - How the Diagnostic works
  - That you cannot help them with any questions

## GET ORGANIZED

- ❑ Find a quiet space for your child to take the assessment
- ❑ Plan for the scheduled time to take the assessment
- ❑ Ensure you have correct login information from your child's teacher.
- ❑ Test the device your child will use to take the Diagnostic. Run our [system check](#) to confirm computers are functioning properly. Consult this [guide](#) if you need help logging in. Confirm headphones or audio are working.
- ❑ Gather paper and pencil for your child to use during the diagnostic.

## SUPPORT YOUR CHILD

- ❑ Monitor and encourage your child as they complete the Diagnostic.
- ❑ Do NOT assist your child with answering assessment questions, as this may lead to the teacher receiving inaccurate information and/or online lessons not being at the right level for your child.

## CONFIRM COMPLETION AND CELEBRATE

- ❑ Ensure your child has fully completed the assessment. Your child will receive a congratulatory message and see lessons appear on their screen. Make sure your child logs off the i-Ready account after completing the assessment. If problems arise, reach out to your child's teacher for support.
