## OVERVIEW

Tottenville High School has been long recognized as a school of academic excellence. Our dedicated faculty is committed to setting high expectations that allow students to flourish. Our programs emphasize college and career preparedness and are aligned with Next Generation Learning Standards (NGLS).

### **The Classics Institute – Code: R30C**

This program is designed to challenge those students who are not only strong in the humanities and language areas, but also interested in pursuing careers in these or related areas.

### **The Science Institute – Code: R30S**

This program is designed to challenge those students who are not only strong in math and science, but also interested in pursuing careers in these or related areas.

### **Academy of Finance – (STEAM) Code: R30A**

The Academy of Finance (AOF) connects high school students with the world of financial services, offering a curriculum that covers banking and credit, financial planning, securities, insurance, accounting, and economics.

### **Advertising & Design Academy – Code: R30G**

The objective of this program of study is to develop a community of learners that possess the ability to acquire knowledge and skills that are needed to move an idea to a commercial reality. Students will develop an understanding of the advertising and design process and the knowledge and skills needed to begin an advertising and design career.

### **Architecture (STEAM) – Code: R30A**

The Architecture Program will give you an understanding of architecture, design, and structures that will prepare you for college and careers. We offer intensive instruction in design sequence. Eligible students are placed in internships with licensed architects. Courses include sequences that concentrate on applied learning skills in Technical Drawing, Pre-Engineering, Architecture, Interior Design, and computer Aided Design.

The zoned program is a comprehensive, academic college preparatory program for students who choose 1-year elective courses over commitment to a 3-year academy.

### **Automotive Academy – Code: R30E**

### **Computer Science Academy (STEAM) – Code: R30A**

This program is designed to teach and prepare the students for further learning in college as well as a career in computer programming. The content is fully web-based, with students writing and running code in the browser.

### **Culinary Arts Academy – Code: R30F**

The Culinary Arts Program at Tottenville High School provides an exciting hands-on approach that will prepare you for entrance into the exciting field of Restaurant Hospitality.

### **Dental Laboratory Technology/Dental Office Careers Program – (STEAM) Code: R30A**

Successful completion of this sequence will give you the required skills essential to the industry. You will also meet the standards for science, as well as, Career & Technical Education (CTE). Our program is the first in the United States to offer Dental Cad/Cam Digital Technology.

### **Health/Medical Assisting Program (STEAM) – Code: R30A**

We offer the Health/Medical Assisting Program for students interested in medical and allied professions. Upon successful course completion, a special CTE endorsement from NYSED will be affixed on the diploma.

### **Junior R.O.T.C. Program – Code: R30B**

The Marine Corps Junior Reserves Officers' Training Corps (JROTC) Program is co-sponsored by the Department of Education and the US Marine Corps. The curriculum is divided into three areas: academic, military and physical fitness and is designed to provide students with a sense of leadership and self-discipline.

### **Performing and Visual Arts – Code: R30H**

This program is comprised of instrumental music, vocal music, and fine arts. Students in these programs are eligible for a Chancellor's Advanced Arts Diploma.

### **The Law & Justice Academy – Code: R30D**

This is a three year sequence of courses related to the legal professions. Students will develop the practical skills and knowledge to evaluate and pursue the wide array of career paths available to them in the legal professions.
