**WELCOME TO THE POLICE OFFICER ROCCO LAURIE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 72!**

My name is Toni Rufo, and I am your Parent Coordinator. I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to I.S. 72 and give you some important information about our school.

Wednesday, September 5, 2018 is the first day of school. Our school day begins at 7:10 a.m. and dismissal is at 1:30 p.m. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade will enter the building through the main entrance on Ferndale Avenue and then be directed to the auditorium to meet their class and first period teacher. At that time they will have an extended first period for orientation.

Buses will be running from the first day of school and if your child is slated to ride the yellow bus, it is suggested they do so from the first day.

Free breakfast and lunch is served daily. The cafeteria doors off the main entrance are open at 6:45 a.m. every day for those who eat breakfast. Even though lunch is free, you are still required to apply for lunch.

Posted on our website ([www.is72.org](http://www.is72.org)) are the summer assignment, photo/video consent form, and immunization requirements for sixth grade. Many wonderful things occur during the school year and we like to document and post them on the school website. Please monitor the website regularly as we use it to communicate important information, including information regarding after school activities.

Please note that we are a PupilPath school!

PupilPath is a website that allows you to view your child's assignments and projects along with due dates; his or her performance in each class including homework, classwork, tests and projects; progress reports from teachers throughout the school year; handouts and assignments when your child is absent from school; your child's transcripts and graduation eligibility status; school announcements, new calendar listings and upcoming events; and your child's attendance.

In September, you will be given an invitation with personalized information for both you and




your student to register. It is very important that you register and monitor PupilPath on a daily basis. All emails are sent home using this website.
