Please have the children prepare for their performance by practicing all assigned music, dances, and songs along with obtaining the necessary materials/costumes they need to provide for a great showcase.


Dance students must arrive with their costumes as per Ms. Causi's directions. Along with this, band and chorus students should be dressed in **"concert attire"** in alignment with the school dress code as follows:

<u>Boys</u>	<u>Girls</u>
1) White dress shirt	1) White top (no tank tops)
2) Black dress pants	2) Black pants/skirt/dress etc. (as per school dress code)
3) Black belt	3) Black shoes
4) Black socks	4) Black belt (if you are wearing a belt)
5) Black Shoes	5) Black socks/stockings/tights/leggings etc.
6) Tie of your choice	6) OR long black dress with black shoes

Each night students are asked to arrive at 6:00 p.m. to allow time for set-up and preparation before the showcase. Parents will be allowed in for seating at 6:50pm. Furthermore, students are required to attend and stay until the end of the performance to support their friends and classmates in other performing groups.
