Listed below is the information you will need regarding High School acceptance results. All information will be provided directly to you from the Office of High School enrollment via your myschools account and via email. Please be sure to check those accounts. If you have any questions, please contact Ms.Iburg, your child's 8th grade guidance counselor.

### NYC Public High School Results:

- ❖ All NYC Public High School results will be released by Friday March 20, 2020 after 3pm.
- ❖ When the results are available, you will receive an e-mail notifying you to log into your Myschools account to view your child's offer.
- ❖ After March 20th, you will also receive your child's High School offer in the mail via the US Postal Service.
- ❖ Students will receive **ONE** offer only. (If your child applied to a Specialized High School, and was accepted, he/she will receive that offer at the same time. If they don't receive a Specialized High School offer, unfortunately he/she was not accepted and can apply again in 9th grade).
- ❖ If a student receives both a High School Acceptance AND a Specialized High School acceptance, families will have to make a decision as to what program is being chosen to attend. Please email Mrs.Iburg with your child's name, class, and their decision.

### Waitlists:

#### There are no longer Round 2 applications or Appeals.

Students are automatically put on the waitlist for each program he/she applied to that is listed higher on their application than their High School offer/acceptance.

#### For example:

A student who gets an offer to their 3rd choice program is automatically on the waitlists for their 1st choice and 2nd choice programs.


A student who gets an offer to their 1st choice program is not automatically on any waitlists.

Families can add students to any waitlist they want after March 20th, by using their MySchools High School account.

- ❖ High Schools are in control of their own waitlists. Please contact the specific High School you are planning to place on you waitlists with any further details regarding availability to the program
- ❖ Offers from waitlists can be made from March 20 - September. If a High School is offering a waitlist seat, the high school will contact you directly with the offer.
