THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM MAY BE ABLE TO HELP. AVAILABLE TO RENTERS OR HOMEOWNERS

CALL THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN YOUR AREA **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** FOR AN APPLICATION. ASK FOR THE ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. APPLICATIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT MOST SITES MID-SEPTEMBER. If you were enrolled with the energy assistance program last year, you may receive notice to apply for this year, from your servicing agency, sent to the mailing address they have on record from last year.
