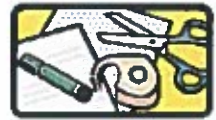


WELCOME TO TEAM 7A!

We are also asking for students to bring in a \$5 activity fee. This fee is used to provide students water, snacks, and supplies for team activities.

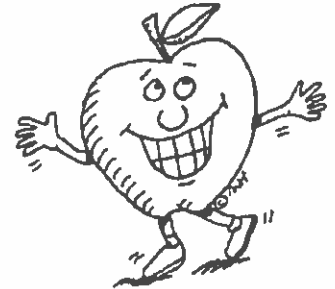

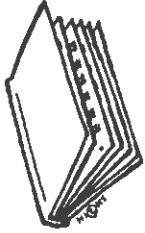
