Reading

Students will be able to integrate information from several texts on the same topic in order to write or speak about the subject they have chosen. They will respond to prompts to show their understanding of the topic and to persuade the reader to see their point of view.

Writing

Students will write an opinion piece on topics or texts, supporting a point of view with reasons and information. They will be able to introduce the topic clearly, state an opinion and create an organized structure. They will provide multiple reasons to support their opinions. They will finalize their work with a concluding statement or paragraph that sums up their essay.

Math

Students will be able to recognize volume as additive. They will be able to find the volume of solid figures composed of two overlapping right rectangular prisms by adding the volumes of the non overlapping parts applying this technique to solve real world problems.
