Writer's Corner



In this unit of all about non-fiction writing the students will use their prior knowledge they have acquired through other writing units and they will acquire new skills such as researching non-fiction topics. Students will utilize their skills of sentence structure, grammar and clear illustrations to create non-fiction text. Students will conduct their research by using non-fiction books about various topics. As the students gather research they will organize their information into categories. As each category is developed students will use features of non-fiction text to create their books. As they are creating their books students will organize their information as to teach others about various topics.

In this unit, we will introduce upper case letters and seventeen high-frequency Tricky Words.

Uppercase Letters:

- A, B, C, D
- E, F, G, H
- I, J, K, L, M
- N, O, P, Q, R
- S, T, U, V, W
- X, Y, Z

High-Frequency Words:

when, word, why, to, where, no, I, what, so, which, once, said, says, are, were, here, there

Students will continue to practice blending two-syllable words and reviewing previously taught tricky words. They will also practice letter-sound correspondences for sounds
