CEP Goal 1

Looking at before and after school programs and how they align to the CEP goals

Panzella- Morning program is attached to 3 CEP goals.

Goal 2- ENL groups we have reorganized invited students based on reading levels- not based on grade. Each group is based on reading level.

CEP Goal 1- 5 ELA classes going on right now

Station work in these groups

CEP Goal 3- 4th/5th grade Math Morning program which is attached to goal 3 of the cep

We have made phone calls to parents and we have an influx of students coming to moring program.

PHOTOGRAPHY program has started. First 10 sessions is targeted for 3rd graders. Alice Austin house provides the materials for the students. On December 19th the students in this program are taking a trip to the Alice Austin house.

At the end of that 10 session program there will be a second 10 session program for 4th graders. That program will run until May.

Disney-

We are auditioning for the play as we speak

We just received a Disney Tech Grant. The grant is going to teach teachers and children the lighting and sound system

Grades 3 and 4 is a clinic style

We do a lottery for student enrollment for all grades

MyOn program - Mr. feldman will talk about student growth and data from the uau students who have been using MyOn in the afterschool program.

Coding is starting soon

It will be open to 3rd,4th,5th graders

Last year, students created apps. This year we will be introducing robotics as well

PAL after school program is in session

Chess and other clubs are offered during this program

Video chat with the founder of MyON

THE MYON founder is explaining the how teachers can look at lexile level for students. You can run the time the students are spending on their lexile level.

Parent component-

Family literacy is a category on the teacher side of MyOn

Parents on the slt can come on the education side of the MyOn login and share resources

Mr. Martuccio- Are there any webinars available

Co-founder there are videos in the my on the teacher side

Mr. Martuccio wants the parents to be able to get to the research section.

Mr. Feldman- are there other languages that the information is available

MyOn - will pass the answer along to mr feldman at a later time

10% of the collection is available in spanish

Ms. Lopez wants to know if her child is reading on level material

If you click on students name you can see what the students have read Can you work on one skill at a time?

Myon- is not a targeted skill based program

You can set up projects where students are reading assigned books and answering skill based questions

What is the research say about MyOn?

"33 mins outside of school a day K-3 gets them in the 90th percentile nationwide."

Is there any way to tell if the students are reading the book to themselves or listening?

You can disable audio option

Audio- always on, always off, weekend only

Do the Teachers College reading levels correlate with lexile?

There are slight differences between the two

For the whole school the average range is 15 mins per day

But UAU is triple that average

33 UAU students - 14 students have moved up 1 level only 7 have stayed the same

Students who recorded less than the 30 minutes didn't seem to move.

Growth seems to correlate with the students reading 30 minutes a night.

Possibly reading after school program using MyOn

Having open availability for an hour after school?

Parent nights possibly making a shift back to instruction, rather than just for fun What can we do at a taste of PS13?

Who is running a taste of PS13.

What does that look like? Set-up? Tables? Workshops?

Making sure everyone is represented-flags

We are going to encourage people to talk about their culture

The UAU after school experience has changed because of MyOn

How turn the read to me function off

Revise the PLC to relaunch the program to teachers

Open hours for an after school computer lab

Connect with local libraries to tell them that our students are coming
